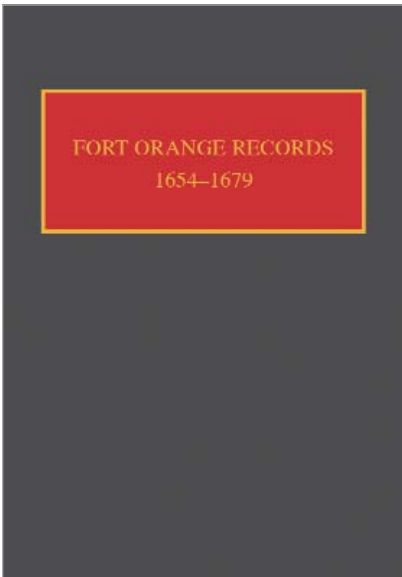

# Fort Orange Records

1 6 5 4 - 1 6 7 9

The records of the Fort Orange Court translated from the Dutch. The court tried civil and minor criminal cases, with jurisdiction over Fort Orange, the village of Beverwijck, Schenectady, Kinderhook, Claverack, Coxsackie, Catskill until 1661. The Court of Fort Orange/Beverwijck served as a judicial, legislative, and executive body for the West India Company's region on the upper Hudson. The records from 1654 to 1679 are translated from the original Dutch. This is part of our New Netherland Document Series.
